

TEDI-London Learning Tree Development.Overview.

TEDI-London is a new Higher Education institution specifically focused on providing engineering education and due to open for students in September 2021. Learning content and collaboration opportunities will be provided through Microsoft Teams and a bespoke UI, called The Learning Tree. The aim of the Learning Tree is to provide students the easy ability to navigate learning content in one place. A prototype has been developed by an in-house developer and a High-Level Design by and external supplier. We are looking for a supplier to work with TEDI-London to develop and manage the full solution.

Selection Criteria.

Three suppliers will be asked to provide bids. Selection will initially be based on the written proposals received, with panel interviews if required.

Selection Criteria	Weighting	Essential Detail
Cost	40%	Cost for delivery against current scope, cost for managed service options – fully managed / 3 rd line support only.
Quality	40%	Functionality, architecture, and operations.
Cultural Fit	20%	Alignment of organisational values and ways of working.
